The following transactions took place during the meeting:

Hon. Principal and chairperson of IQAC, Dr. T.A. Chavan extended a warm welcome to all IQAC committee members and briefed about the progress of the college along with the purpose of meeting.

Dr. T.A. Chavan then asked Dr. S. J. Madki (Coordinator and member secretary) to start the meeting as per following agenda.

Agenda 1: 1. Confirmation of minutes of meeting held on 23-03-2026

Resolution 1: Coordinator & member Secretary, Dr S J Madki read the minutes of last meeting held on 23-03-2026 and the same were confirmed unanimously. Also the Action Taken Report based on the suggestions from the previous IQAC meeting was presented and reviewed and accepted unanimously by the members.

Agenda 2: 2. Result analysis of DBATU Exam Sem-I of A Y 2025-26 for information

Resolution 2: Dr. S J Madki presented the detail result analysis of DBATU Exam Sem-I of A Y. 2025-26.

Through discussion it was unanimously resolved as follows:

Dr. P. J. Kulkarni suggested that although academic marks are important, skills play a more significant role in enhancing students' employability. He stated that, as a general eligibility criterion followed by many employers is 60%, the result target may initially be considered at 60%. He further suggested that, considering the varying difficulty levels of different subjects, the target for each subject may be set accordingly.

Prof. C. B. Nadagouda emphasised the need to set a slightly higher target of 70% to encourage better academic performance and continuous improvement. He suggested that the target for all subjects should be kept at 70%.

After discussion and deliberation, the committee decided to set the overall class result target at 70% for all classes. The performance shall be reviewed after the examination, and appropriate quality improvement measures shall be undertaken based on the analysis of the results.

The committee appreciated the result of First Year Engineering and congratulated Dr A S Patil Head of First Year Engineering Dept and all First year faculties for the same. The committee also appreciated Mathematics teachers Prof S V Palmur and Prof B S Murkute for the improvements in their subject results.

Agenda 5: Approval of Human Resource Policy

Resolution 5: Dr. S. J. Madki presented the draft of Human Resource Policy. The draft policy was approved with certain corrections. Dr S P Rajguru suggested to include clause for appraisal of non-teaching staff separately.

The suggestions were noted for necessary incorporation, and the revised policy was approved subject to the inclusion of the recommended corrections.

Agenda 6: Approval of Green Waste Policy

Resolution 6: Dr. S J Madki presented the draft of Green Waste Policy before the committee.

The committee discussed the draft policy and approved it with following suggestions.

Dr. S. P. Rajguru suggested incorporating the term "**Sustainability**" in the title of the policy instead of using the term "Green Policy", in order to give the policy a broader and more appropriate focus on sustainable campus practices.

Accordingly, the policy was renamed as "**Waste Management Policy for Sustainable Campus**".

Agenda 7: Donation of UEF-VIVADO-ENTER-50 users' software by AMD to E&TC Dept. for information

Resolution 7: Dr. S. C. Mhamane shared detailed information regarding the donation of UEF-VIVADO-ENTER-50 Users' Software by AMD to the Electronics and Telecommunication (E&TC) Engineering Department. He told that the software is suitable for teaching, laboratory work, student projects, and research in various areas, including digital design, embedded systems, signal processing, communication, and hardware acceleration.

The committee appreciated the initiative taken by Dr. S. C. Mhamane for facilitating the acquisition of the software, which will strengthen the academic, laboratory, project, and research activities of the E&TC Department and, in turn, contribute to the overall development of the Institute.
